July 29, 2020 was this year's Earth Overshoot Day, the earliest since the 1970's. Overshoot Day is the day of the year that humans on earth have used all of the Earth's natural resources that it could sustainably provide in one year.

We are using resources 1.75 times faster than is sustainable. Things must change. Earth's Overshoot Day was broadcasted across social media and got the attention of people worldwide. There are solutions but we must act now.
